Call for Papers

The participants are requested to send their abstracts (not exceeding 500 words) with 4 or 5 keywords latest by 31st December, 2022, and after intimation of acceptance, full papers for publication in the edited book (with ISBN) latest by 31st January, 2023. The submitted papers will be reviewed by the expert committee. Only recommended papers will be considered for publication in the edited book (with ISBN) by reputed publishers. Abstract Submission Guidelines

- Abstracts must be written in Times New Roman, 12 font size and 1.5 spacing without insertion of any special symbol, formula, diagram, table, or reference.
- The sequence of the abstracts be:
 - o Title in running text
 - Authors name
 - Affiliation and Address
 - o Email id and mobile
 - Abstract body
 - Key words
- Abstract titles should be clear and concise.
- Full names, affiliations, and emails of all authors should be included.
- Abstract should be clearly indicate the research problem, the methodology and results of the work within 500 words.
- All abstract will be reviewed by the Expert Committee and may be sent back for revision, if required.
- Decisions regarding acceptance will be intimated before 31st January, 2023. However, persons attending the Seminar without abstracts can be directly proceed for registration.

About Jamia Millia Islamia

Jamia Millia Islamia came into existence at Aligarh in 1920 (later moved to Delhi in 1925) during the Khilafat and Non-cooperation movement in the response to Gandhiji's call to boycott government supported educational institutions. Today Jamia Millia Islamia is ranked at 3rd position in the country amongst universities in NIRF 2022 rankings issued by the Ministry of Education, Govt of India. It was accredited with the highest grade of 'A++' by the NAAC, Ministry of Education in the second cycle of assessment in 2021. The university has also been consistently ranked amongst leading universities in the world by the renowned international ranking agencies as a comprehensive researchintensive institution. The university has received the prestigious "Research award of President of India" twice and many of its students are recipients of Prime Minister's research fellowship. The university recognizes both teaching and research as areas of focus.

JMI is an ensemble of a multi-layered educational system which covers all aspects of schooling, under-graduate, post-graduate, Ph.D. and post-doctoral education. With 10 faculties of learning, 40 teaching and research departments, over 30 centers of learning and research, 190 courses, approximately 800 faculty members and more than 20000 students.

About the Department

The Department of Teacher Training & Non-Formal Education was established as a Teacher Training Institute in 1938 under the inspiring leadership of Dr. Zakir Husain in response to the need to prepare teachers for the Basic Education Scheme launched by Mahatma Gandhi in 1937. This Teacher Training Institute (TTI) was perhaps the first of its kind in the country to have started training of teachers for Basic schools which were offering crafts centered indigenous education to children. The TTI gradually expanded its activities and got developed into Teachers' College.

The Department of Teacher Training & Non-Formal Education of the JMI was the first institution in the country to have been upgraded to Institute of Advanced Studies in Education (IASE) in 1988. This upgradation had accorded due recognition to the past services and contributions made by the Department to the cause of teacher education and had expressed the faith of the Government in the progressive traditions of this historic institution. The purpose of upgradation is to develop the institution into a Centre of excellence in teaching and research. The broad functions of the Institute are: imparting pre-service and in-service

education to the secondary/special education/elementary/nursery school teachers; preparing personnel for elementary teacher education institutions and their continuing education; developing and publishing for dissemination useful material for teachers and teacher-educators; and undertaking research, innovation and extension work in the field. The Institute had been carrying out most of these functions even before its upgradation as an IASE except that now there is an enhanced emphasis on continuing education. The Institute publishes quality material produced by its faculty for use by the classroom practitioners. Department of Teacher Training & Non-formal Education (Institute of Advanced studies in Education) is a comprehensive Teacher Education Institution which offers all Teacher Education course from Diploma to Ph.D.
